The Seminar was held in the classrooms of Harvard School of
Public Health in Boston, (Massachusetts) under the direction
of Dr. Paul Campbell, the Coordination Lic. María Adela
Contreras and Dr. Enrique Schiavon (MD).

The training program included visits to health centers in
Boston to see in practice application of theoretical concepts

developed in class.

Since 1997 the seminars covering different topics that were motivators at the time and in the Latin American system environment health. The theme of the last seminar was the new trends in finance, technology and care modalities, with special reference to new payment to physicians and the problems caused by litigation. Another important issue was the new therapies, including advances in gene therapy, more sophisticated drugs and their impact on Health Sector costs. The proposed by Dr. Campbell objective was to discuss some aspects of the model of health care in the United States and global trends, to analyze its concrete application in Latin America. The seminar did not propose "recipes" just ideas to discuss.

The axes of the program were the reforms in the financial system in the United States and other countries Latin American public health in the twenty-first century, patient safety, new technologies management, and the changes produced by the advance of genomics. Another important aspect was the evaluation cost control and progress in implementation of quality and efficiency.

The seminar was a success and a unique experience. To walk the halls of a University founded in 1636 and gave more than 20 Nobel Laureates in Medicine, was a real honor and satisfaction staff for the moments.
